## DIMOND HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® ALASKA VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

A two-time First Team All-State selection, Nielson amassed 13 digs, 11 kills and six assists in the Class 4A state final against South Anchorage High.

Nielson has maintained a 3.76 GPA in the classroom. A member of the National Honor Society, she is also a decorated track and field athlete and has participated in the Anchorage School District Gifted Student Mentoring program.

"Deanna Nielson is a player with huge talent, a great attitude and work ethic," said Judy Knecht, head coach of rival South Anchorage High. "She is extremely versatile and she really turned it on in the state tournament and gave her team everything she had."

Nielson remains undecided upon a college destination.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by ESPN RISE and the Gatorade high school sports leadership team, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.

Nielson joins recent Gatorade Alaska Volleyball Players of the Year Taylor Adams (2009-10, Dimond), Lauren Fulton (2008-09, Dimond) and Sarah Hibbert (2007-08, South Anchorage) among the state's list of former award winners.
