She's also a three-time First Team All-State selection.

Manthorpe has maintained a 3.61 GPA in the classroom. A devoted member of her church community, she has volunteered locally on behalf of the Special Olympics and Allie's Friends Foundation, which provides comfort for children in medical emergencies.

"She's a left-handed setter who does everything exceptionally well," said George Trabosh, head coach of rival Mt. St. Joseph Academy. "She can attack the ball when called upon, and she has great court presence and leadership."

Manthorpe has signed a National Letter of Intent to play volleyball on scholarship at Seton Hall University beginning in the fall of 2011.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by ESPN RISE and the Gatorade high school sports leadership team, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.

Manthorpe joins recent Gatorade Pennsylvania Volleyball Players of the Year Kate Begor (2009-10, Mt. Lebanon), Danielle Carrozza (2008-09, Merion Mercy Academy) and Helen Fitzpatrick (2007-08, Merion Mercy Academy) among the state's list of former award winners.
