MEHLVILLE HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® MISSOURI BOYS SOCCER PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The 6-foot-3, 185-pound senior forward recorded 23 goals and eight assists this past season, leading the Panthers (20-5) to the Class 3, District 2 championship game. An All-American selection by the National Soccer Coaches Association of America and the Missouri Coaches Association's Class 3 Offensive Player of the Year, Gabeljic was a *St. Louis Post-Dispatch* First Team All-Metro honoree and the Suburban West Conference Player of the Year.

Gabeljic has maintained a 3.61 GPA in the classroom. He has volunteered as a local youth soccer instructor and on behalf of the Special Olympics.

"Adnan Gabeljic is one of the most dynamic players we've played against in years," said Greg Vitello, head coach of rival DeSmet Jesuit High. "He is just awesome. He left some of our guys in the dust with his skill and athleticism. He is special."

Gabeljic has signed a National Letter of Intent to play soccer on scholarship at St. Louis University this fall and graduated Mehlville High early to begin attending spring semester collegiate classes.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by ESPN RISE and the Gatorade high school sports leadership team, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.

Gabeljic joins recent Gatorade Missouri Boys Soccer Players of the Year Alex Sweetin (2008-09, Rockhurst), Will Bruin (2007-08, De Smet Jesuit), and Mike Roach (2006-07, Chaminade College Preparatory School) among the state's list of former award winners.
