FORT DORCHESTER HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® SOUTH CAROLINA BOYS BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The 6-foot-8, 195-pound senior guard/forward led the Patriots (22-4) to the Class 4A quarterfinals this past season, averaging 22.7 points, 12.4 rebounds, 6.7 blocks and 3.1 assists per game. A 2009 First Team All-State selection, Slawson led all scorers with 22 points to help Fort Dorchester rally to beat Wando High in the second round of the state tournament. Slawson is ranked as the nation's No. 82 in the Class of 2010 by ESPNU.

Slawson has maintained a 3.42 GPA in the classroom. He has volunteered locally as a summer basketball camp counselor, a youth mentor for elementary school students and as a caretaker for the elderly.

"R.J. Slawson is a complete game-changer," said Fort Dorchester High Head Coach Leon Wheaton. "He is the type of guy who completely fills up the stat sheet in each category. He is a very humble player who has changed the basketball atmosphere at Fort Dorchester."

Slawson has signed a National Letter of Intent to play basketball on scholarship at the University of South Carolina this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. Slawson joins recent Gatorade South Carolina Boys Basketball Players of the Year Milton Jennings (2008-09 & 2007-08, Pinewood Preparatory School) and Trevor Deloach (2006-07, Saluda) among the state's list of former award winners.
