PEORIA NOTRE DAME HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® ILLINOIS BOYS SOCCER PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The 6-foot-2, 195-pound senior forward led the Irish to a 26-1 record and the Class 2A state championship this past season. Cicciarelli recorded 36 goals and 15 assists, including a goal and assist in Notre Dame's 8-0 win over Ridgewood High in the title game. A 2010 ESPN RISE First Team All-American selection and the Illinois High School Soccer Coaches Association State Player of the Year, Cicciarelli is a member of the U.S. Soccer Under-18 Men's National Team Player Pool. He concluded his prep soccer career with 96 goals and 51 assists.

Cicciarelli has maintained a 3.51 GPA in the classroom. He has volunteered locally at a child care center and as a youth soccer coach and counselor.

"Vince Cicciarelli is a big-time athlete," said Dale Schilly, Cicciarelli's club coach with Scott Gallagher. "He scores goals and is extremely fast. He's big as well, thick and strong and physical. He's just got such a special athletic quality."

Cicciarelli has signed a National Letter of Intent to play soccer on scholarship at the University of Notre Dame this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by ESPN RISE and the Gatorade high school sports leadership team, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.

Cicciarelli joins recent Gatorade Illinois Boys Soccer Players of the Year Bryan Ciesiulka (2009-10, Neuqua Valley), Tim Zimmer (2008-09, Naperville Central), and John Shakon (2007-08, Hinsdale Central) among the state's list of former award winners.
