Hutto has maintained a 3.50 GPA in the classroom. An active member of his school's Multicultural Club, he has also participated in student government and school theatrical productions.

"He's got great feet and a knack for scoring and creating goals," said Laef Eggan, head coach of rival Anchorage West High. "He reads the field well, he's got great anticipation and good technical ability."

Hutto has signed a National Letter of Intent to play soccer on scholarship at Colorado State University-Pueblo this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport.
