## CREIGHTON PREP STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® NEBRASKA BOYS SOCCER PLAYER OF THE YEAR

At the time of his selection, Linden had scored 14 goals and passed for 12 assists. A 2010 *Omaha World Herald* First-Team All-State selection, Linden is a member of the U.S. Youth Soccer 1993 Region II Olympic Development Program team.

Linden has maintained a B average in the classroom. A member of the Creighton Prep choir, he has volunteered locally as a middle school tutor and as a youth basketball and soccer coach.

"Jake really goes where they need him and he just does it," said Andy Benkis, a state ODP coach. "He sacrifices himself to do what's best for the team. He's really fast, a big strong kid, and he's one of those kids who is just a leader. He always does the right thing."

Linden has signed a National Letter of Intent to play soccer on scholarship at Xavier University in Cincinnati this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by ESPN RISE and the Gatorade high school sports leadership team, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.
