SALESIANUM SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® DELAWARE BASEBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The 6-foot, 180-pound senior second baseman batted .549 with three home runs and 18 RBIs, leading Salesianum to a 16-4 record and the state semifinals. A 2010 First Team All-Non-Conference selection, Lamberton also posted a 1.467 OPS and stole five bases in five attempts.

Lamberton has maintained a 4.17 GPA in the classroom. A member of the National Honor Society and a U.S. Presidential Scholar award-winner, he has volunteered locally on behalf of the Special Olympics and his school's campus ministry mission.

"Lincoln Lamberton is always striving for excellence in all that he does," said Salesianum School head coach Ted Godfrey. "His character, attitude and work ethic are off the charts."

Lamberton has signed a National Letter of Intent to play baseball on scholarship at the University of North Carolina this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by ESPN RISE and the Gatorade high school sports leadership team, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.

Lamberton joins recent Gatorade Delaware Baseball Players of the Year Taylor Mahoney (2009-10, St. Mark's), Eric Buckland (2008-09; Caravel Academy), Derrik Gibson (2007-08, Seaford), and Derrik Gibson (2006-07, Seaford), among the state's list of former award winners.
