POLAND SEMINARY HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® OHIO SOFTBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

CHICAGO (June 9, 2011) — In its 26th year of honoring the nation's best high school athletes, The Gatorade Company, in collaboration with ESPN RISE, today announced Erin Gabriel of Poland Seminary High School as its 2010-11 Gatorade Ohio Softball Player of the Year. The 5-foot-7 junior right-handed pitcher led the Bulldogs (25-2) to the Division II state championship this past season. Gabriel posted a 16-1 record in the circle with a 0.82 ERA and 233 strikeouts in 110 innings pitched. Also the 2009-10 Gatorade Ohio Softball Player of the Year, Gabriel batted .571 with eight home runs, 46 RBIs and a 1.029 slugging percentage this spring.

Gabriel has maintained a 4.0 GPA in the classroom. A member of her school's French Club and Science Club, she has volunteered locally on behalf of the National Honor Society and the Mahoning County Board of Developmental Disabilities.

"Erin Gabriel is the best softball player to come out of this area in a long time, if not the best ever," said Ronie Haurin, head coach of rival Canfield High. "She is very polite and such a team player. Her physical achievements on the field are amazing."

Gabriel has verbally committed to play softball on scholarship at the University of Tennessee beginning in the fall of 2012.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by ESPN RISE and the Gatorade high school sports leadership team, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.
