## SOUTH ANCHORAGE HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® ALASKA VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

A two-time First Team All-State selection, she helped South Anchorage to an undefeated season against in-state competition and she had 35 assists in the state title-clinching victory against Dimond High.

Hooe has maintained a 3.44 GPA in the classroom. She has volunteered locally on behalf of the Special Olympics and as a youth volleyball coach.

"Morgan Hooe possesses great athletic ability and is very technically skilled," said Brian Stenehjem, head coach of rival Service High. "She is a true competitor with a desire to succeed."

Hooe has verbally committed to play volleyball on an athletic scholarship at Boise State beginning in the fall of 2013.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by ESPNHS and the Gatorade high school sports leadership team, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.

Hooe joins recent Gatorade Alaska Volleyball Players of the Year Deanna Nielson (2010-11, Dimond High School), Taylor Adams (2009-10, Dimond) and Lauren Fulton (2008-09, Dimond) among the state's list of former award winners.
