## TRIPOLI HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® IOWA VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Gilbert has maintained a 3.95 GPA in the classroom. A member of the National Honor Society and her school's chapter of Students Against Destructive Decisions, she has volunteered locally on behalf of a food pantry and her church's Sunday School program.

"She's just an outstanding volleyball player," said Janesville High Head Coach Shelly Sorensen. "She's very hard to stop in the front row, and she also plays good defense and can hit out of the back row."

Gilbert has signed a National Letter of Intent to play volleyball on scholarship at St. Louis University beginning in the fall of 2012.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by ESPNHS and the Gatorade high school sports leadership team, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.

Gilbert joins recent Gatorade Iowa Volleyball Players of the Year Ali Stark (2010-11, Mt. Vernon High School), Hannah Willms (2009-10, Dike-New Hartford) and Chelsey Semprini (2008-09, Ankeny) among the state's list of former award winners.
