## ARCHBISHOP ALTER HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® OHIO VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Courtney has maintained a 3.45 GPA in the classroom. A devoted parishioner in her church community, where she is a Eucharistic minister, she is a member of her school's Spanish Club and has volunteered locally as a Catholic Youth Organization volleyball coach.

"Megan Courtney is a fabulous player," said Tracey Korneau, head coach of rival Lakota West High. "She is heads and shoulders above any players I have seen this year."

Courtney has signed a National Letter of Intent to play volleyball on scholarship at Penn State University beginning in the fall of 2012

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by ESPNHS and the Gatorade high school sports leadership team, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.
