Through 35 games, Ennis averaged 15.2 points, 7.1 assists, 4.6 rebounds and 2.5 steals. A First Team All-State performer, he's a member of Canada's U-19 Men's National Team and is rated as the nation's No. 41 recruit in the Class of 2013 by ESPNU.

Ennis has maintained a 3.29 GPA in the classroom. He has volunteered locally assisting the homeless.

"Ennis has strength and size and he does all the things a coach could want him to do," said Billy Armstrong, head coach at Bergen Catholic. "He can shoot it, and he runs his team well. He's just a really good point guard with a very athletic body."

Ennis will begin his senior year of high school this fall.
