DIMOND HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE ALASKA BOYS SOCCER PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The 5-foot-8 senior midfielder has led the Lynx to a 13-1 record entering the regional playoffs against Bartlett, scheduled for May 17. Sedor scored 10 goals and passed for seven assists in the regular season. He was a Second Team All-Cook Inlet Conference selection and a member of the All-State Tournament Team in 2011.

Sedor has maintained a 4.14 GPA in the classroom. A member of his school's swing choir, he has served in student government and has participated in recycling and environmental awareness initiatives with Dimond's Green Effects club.

"Sedor is super quick and he's one of the smartest players I've seen," said Dan Rufner, head coach at Service High. "He's a really good leader and he makes everyone around him better."

Sedor will attend Gonzaga this fall, where he will play soccer.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport.
