JESUIT HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE LOUISANA BOYS SOCCER PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The 6-foot-1 senior defender scored nine goals and passed for six assists this past season, leading the Blue Jays (27-1-4) to the Division I state championship and a No. 7 ranking nationally in the ESPNHS Fab 50. Hicks was the state Division I Player of the Year and the Times-Picayune Defensive Player of the Year

Hicks has maintained a 3.38 GPA in the classroom. He has volunteered locally on behalf of Habitat for Humanity and an area homeless shelter.

"Hicks is big, fast, good in the air," said Louie Smothermon, head coach at Brother Martin High. "He was a great leader for his team, one of those kids with a refuse-to-lose mentality."

Hicks will attend Louisiana State University this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by ESPNHS and the Gatorade high school sports leadership team, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.
