At the time of his selection, Cody owned a 4-0 record with a 0.76 ERA and 74 strikeouts in 37 innings-pitched. A 2011 First Team All-State honoree, he also batted .419 with 12 RBIs and 11 runs scored through 20 games.

Cody has maintained a 3.45 GPA in the classroom. A devoted member of his church community, he has volunteered locally on behalf of an area homeless shelter, as a youth baseball camp counselor and as part of multiple clean-up initiatives in his town.

"Kyle Cody is an extremely hard worker and a goal-oriented individual," said McDonell Central Catholic High head coach Eric Wedemeyer. "He sets his mind to a goal and strives to be the best that he can be."

Cody has signed a National Letter of Intent to play baseball on an athletic scholarship at the University of Kentucky this
