EAST HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® IOWA SOFTBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Fisher posted a 23-3 record with a 1.10 ERA in the circle, while batting .325 with 13 home runs and 48 RBI. The 2011 Class 4A Pitcher of the Year, she is a two-time First Team All-State selection and was named to the All-State Tournament team.

Fisher has maintained a 4.02 GPA in the classroom. She has volunteered locally on behalf of the Kiwanis Miracle League, assisting physically and intellectually challenged youth athletes, and has participated in the Scarlet Santa Program, providing gifts for needy children.

"Fisher has worked hard and become a game-changer for East," said Kim Wright-Jones, head coach at Urbandale High. "She is definitely an amazing pitcher."

Fisher has signed a National Letter of Intent to play softball on scholarship at Iowa State University this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport.
