C.M. RUSSELL HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE MONTANA BOYS SOCCER PLAYER OF THE YEAR

CHICAGO (February 22, 2012) — In its 27th year of honoring the nation's best high school athletes, The Gatorade Company, in collaboration with ESPNHS, today announced Nick Downs of C.M. The 5-foot-8, 140-pound junior forward scored 14 goals and passed for eight assists this past season, leading the Rustlers (6-8-1) to the Class AA state quarterfinals. A two-time All-State selection and a two-time Montana Coaches Association Academic All-State honoree, Downs is a member of the 1994 U.S. Youth Soccer Region IV Olympic Development Program team. Through his junior year, he has recorded 32 goals and 13 assists in his prep career.

Downs has maintained a B-plus average in the classroom. He has volunteered locally as a youth mentor and on behalf of the Kick for Nick charitable campaign by donating his time as a soccer coach in exchange for soccer balls sent to children in Afghanistan and Irag.

"Nick Downs is fast, he's quick, he's good with the ball at his feet and he can finish," said Paul Zazenski, Downs' club coach with Montana United. "His speed allows him to do what he wants on the pitch."

Downs will begin his senior year of high school this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by ESPNHS and the Gatorade high school sports leadership team, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.
