ST. BENEDICT'S PREP. STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE NEW JERSEY BOYS SOCCER PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The 5-foot-7, 140-pound senior forward led the Gray Bees to a 24-0 record and the New Jersey Prep A state championship this past season. Francois scored 44 goals and passed for 22 assists, including a goal and an assist in a 4-1 win over Pennington School in the state final. The 2011 Newark Star Ledger New Jersey Prep Player of the Year, Francois is a two-time First Team Prep All-State selection. He concluded his two seasons at St. Benedict's with 60 goals and 41 assists.

Francois has maintained a B average in the classroom. A refugee from Haiti who came to the United States two years ago, he has volunteered locally as a youth soccer coach and on behalf of the Special Olympics in addition to serving as a gospel singer in his church choir.

"Christiano Francois is a fabulous player. His speed and technical ability make him as dynamic as any player I have seen in New Jersey over the last decade," said Ryan Spring, head coach of Blair Academy. "He is a tireless worker who is constantly making runs, finding space and creating opportunities for himself and his teammates."

Francois has signed a National Letter of Intent to play soccer on an athletic scholarship at the University of Maryland this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by ESPNHS and the Gatorade high school sports leadership team, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.
