VERITAS PREPARATORY ACADEMY STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® ARIZONA VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Sponcil recorded 530 assists, 438 kills, 2220 digs, 69 service aces and 39 blocks while posting a .570 kill percentage. A two-time First Team All-State selection, she collected 25 assists, 18 digs and 15 kills in the state final against Valley Lutheran High.

Sponcil has maintained a 3.24 GPA in the classroom. She has volunteered locally as a peer mentor and as a youth volleyball coach.

"Sarah Sponcil is the best player I've seen in my 11 years of coaching," said Brad Bode, head coach at Arizona Lutheran Academy. "She is also the smartest player I've seen and she is able to elevate everyone else's play around her. She gets the ball to whomever she needs to get it to. She could start for any team in the state.

Sponcil will begin her senior year of high school next fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by the Gatorade high school sports leadership team in partnership with USA TODAY High School Sports, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.

Sponcil joins recent Gatorade Arizona Volleyball Players of the Year Bianca Arellano (2011-12, Xavier College Prep.), Madison Kingdon (2010-11, Sunnyslope High School), Stephanie Preach (2009-10 & 2008-09, Xavier College Prep.), and Cat Highmark (2007-08, Chaparral) among the state's list of former award winners.
