"Crable was outstanding this year," said Eric Garvey, head coach at Sacred Heart Academy. "She's more than just a great hitter. She's also an outstanding blocker and she plays all six rotations."

Crable will begin her senior year of high school next fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport.
