EDEN PRAIRIE HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® MINNESOTA VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Also the 2011-12 Gatorade Minnesota Volleyball Player of the Year, Wilhite is a 2012-13 American Volleyball Coaches Association Under Armour First Team All-American.

Wilhite has maintained a 3.90 GPA in the classroom. An accomplished vocalist with her school's treble choir and women's concert chorale, she has volunteered locally as a youth volleyball coach and as part of multiple community service initiatives in association with the National Honor Society.

"Sarah Wilhite is one of the finest players I have ever coached," said Eden Prairie head coach Chad Becker. "She is a true team leader and her work ethic is unmatched."

Wilhite has signed a National Letter of Intent to play volleyball on an athletic scholarship at the University of Minnesota beginning in the fall of 2013.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by the Gatorade high school sports leadership team in partnership with USA TODAY High School Sports, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.
