LONG BEACH HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® MISSISSIPPI VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

"Hedin is a freak of nature," said David Irwin, head coach at Hancock High. "She's so athletic. If you set the ball anywhere near her, she can hit it."

Hedin has verbally committed to play soccer on scholarship at the University of Southern Mississippi beginning in the fall of 2013.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by the Gatorade high school sports leadership team in partnership with USA TODAY High School Sports, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.
