Schirmer has maintained an A average in the classroom. Vice president of her class and also a talented musician, she has helped raise funds for breast cancer awareness.

"Schirmer is a tremendous all-around player," said Andrew Solomon, head coach at Penfield High. "She hits over the top of blocks and she also plays great defense. You can't really stop her, you can only slow her down."

Schirmer will begin her senior year of high school next fall.
