## MOUNT NOTRE DAME HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® OHIO VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Strizak has maintained a 4.0 GPA in the classroom. An active parishioner in her church community, she has volunteered locally at a daycare center as a youth basketball and volleyball coach and on behalf of the American Cancer Society's Relay for Life.

"Michelle Strizak is a game-changer," said Denise Harvey, head coach at Mother of Mercy High. "She propels her team and can singlehandedly take over a match. She is effective all over the floor and uses her skills very well. I feel her game has improved over the years and she can and does dominate the scene."

Strizak has signed a National Letter of Intent to play volleyball on an athletic scholarship at the University of Illinois beginning in the fall of 2013.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport.
