## PARKLAND HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® PENNSYLVANIA VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

A 2012-13 Under Armour First Team All-American, Robertson is a two-time All-State selection and MVP of the Lehigh Valley Conference.

Robertson has maintained a 3.49 GPA in the classroom. She volunteered locally on behalf of youth sports camps and a food bank.

"She's a dominating player," said Don West, head coach at Southern Lehigh High. "She's got a quick leap and a great vertical, and she can play great defense. She can do anything you need her to do."

Robertson has verbally committed to play volleyball at Penn State University beginning in the fall of 2013.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by the Gatorade high school sports leadership team in partnership with USA TODAY High School Sports, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.
