## RAVENWOOD HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® TENNESSEE VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Hutson has maintained a 3.73 GPA in the classroom. A member of Students Taking a Right Stand, she has volunteered locally on behalf of Ronald McDonald House Charities and youth volleyball programs.

"Hutson is just a dominant player," said Brittany Rhinehart, head coach at Centennial High. "You have to know where she is on the court, because they're going to push the ball to her, even in the back row. She's the type of player who makes you change the way you play."

Hutson will begin her senior year of high school next fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport.
