Devine has maintained a 4.09 GPA in the classroom. She has volunteered locally on behalf of a food bank and youth basketball programs.

"Devine has a great all-around game," said Steve Caciari, head coach at West Valley High. "She's a versatile scorer with nice ball-handling skills, and she plays with a great deal of desire and determination."

Devine has signed a National Letter of Intent to play basketball on scholarship at the University of Alaska-Anchorage this fall
