The 6-foot-5, 190-pound senior guard led the Hawks to a 24-6 record and the semifinals of the Class AAAA tournament this past season. Vasturia averaged 20.5 points, 7.1 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game. A First Team All-State selection, he is a two-time Philadelphia Catholic League MVP.

Vasturia has maintained a 3.49 GPA in the classroom. He has volunteered locally on behalf of youth basketball programs.

"Vasturia makes everyone better," said Joe Dempsey, head coach at rival La Salle College High. "He gets double-teamed a lot and always makes the right pass. Defensively, he guards the best player on the other team."

Vasturia has signed a National Letter of Intent to play basketball on scholarship at the University of Notre Dame this fall.
