CHEYENNE EAST HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE WYOMING GIRLS SOCCER PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Erickson has maintained a 3.88 GPA in the classroom. Also a basketball standout, she has volunteered locally on behalf of the Special Olympics and youth sports programs.

"She's a very skilled player," said Tom Racette, head coach at Sheridan High. "She's aggressive on the ball and she makes great decisions."

Erickson will begin her senior year of high school this fall.
