HUNTINGTON NORTH HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® INDIANA SOFTBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The 5-foot-9 junior left-handed pitcher led the Vikings (26-3) to the Semi-State finals this past season. Rethlake posted a 23-1 record and a 0.18 ERA in the circle, compiling 317 strikeouts and just 23 walks in 154 innings pitched. She added a .486 batting average with 14 home runs and 36 RBI. Rethlake is a First Team All-State selection.

Rethlake has maintained a 3.75 GPA in the classroom. She has volunteered locally on behalf of youth softball programs.

"Rethlake is a tremendous competitor," said Jeff Theobald, head coach at New Castle High. "She has great control and command of her pitches, and as good a pitcher as she is, I think she's equally as good at the plate."

Rethlake will begin her senior year of high school this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport.
