HOOVER HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® OHIO SOFTBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The 5-foot-4 junior right-handed shortstop led the Crimson Tide to a 32-0 record and the Division I semifinals, scheduled for June 6. Lilley batted .697 with seven home runs, 53 RBI and 46 runs scored through 32 games. A 2012 First Team All-State selection, she has produced an .804 on-base percentage and a 1.303 slugging percentage.

Lilley has maintained a 3.91 GPA in the classroom. She has volunteered locally on behalf of the Humane Society of the United States, the YMCA and helped raise awareness of the dangers of drug and alcohol abuse.

"Jenna Lilley is always encouraging, inspiring and motiving other players with her positive attitude and play," said North Canton Hoover High head coach Jerry Goodpasture. "She is a great teammate and a joy to coach."

Lilley has made a verbal commitment to play softball on an athletic scholarship at the University of Oregon beginning in the fall of 2014.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport.
