"Deal is a tough guy to stop," said Aaron Brady, head coach at Gonzaga College High. "He runs hard and he runs downhill and it takes two or three guys to tackle him on every play."

Deal has verbally committed to play football on an athletic scholarship at the University of Wisconsin beginning in the fall of 2014.
