Detering has maintained a 3.52 GPA in the classroom. She has volunteered locally at an area soup kitchen during the holidays and as a youth volleyball coach.

Detering has signed a National Letter of Intent to play volleyball on an athletic scholarship at the University of Florida beginning in the fall of 2014.
