The 5-foot-10 sophomore right-handed pitcher had led the Bulldogs to a 28-0 record entering the June 3 regional championship game against Munster. Elish posted a 23-0 record and a 0.22 ERA in the circle through 28 games, amassing 223 strikeouts againt just 17 walks in 126 innings pitched. A First Team All-State selection, she added a .480 batting average with four home runs and 26 RBI.

Elish has maintained a 3.64 GPA in the classroom. A peer tutor in her school, she has volunteered locally on behalf of the Best Buddies program, which matches students with developmentally disabled individuals.

"Elish is the top pitcher we've seen," said Brooke Baker-Runyon, head coach at Andrean High. "She throws hard and she's very smart on the mound. She has a lot of pitches, she gets ahead in the count and she hits her spots."

Elish will begin her junior year of high school this fall.

The <u>Gatorade Player of the Year</u> program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport.
