## BUTTE HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE MONTANA BOYS TRACK & FIELD ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

CHICAGO (June 20, 2014) — In its 29<sup>th</sup> year of honoring the nation's best high school athletes, The Gatorade Company, in collaboration with USA TODAY High School Sports, today announced Dalton Daum of Butte High School as its 2013-14 Gatorade Montana Boys Track & Field Athlete of the Year. Daum is the first Gatorade Montana Boys Track & Field Athlete of the Year to be chosen from Butte High School.

The award, which recognizes not only outstanding athletic excellence, but also high standards of academic achievement and exemplary character demonstrated on and off the track, distinguishes Daum as Montana's best high school boys track & field athlete. Now a finalist for the prestigious Gatorade National Boys Track & Field Athlete of the Year award to be announced in June, Daum joins an elite alumni association of state award-winners in 12 sports, including Ryan Hall (1999-01, Big Bear HS, Calif.), Meb Keflezighi (1993-94, San Diego HS, Calif.), Derek Jeter (1991-92, Kalamazoo HS, Mich.), Candace Parker (2001-02, Naperville Central HS, Ill.), Mark Sanchez (2004-05, Mission Viejo HS, Calif.) and Lolo Jones (1997-98, Roosevelt HS, Ia.).

The 6-foot-2, 175-pound junior sprinter won a pair of individual state championships this spring and led the Bulldogs to a 12th-place finish as a team at the Class AA state meet. Daum took gold in the 100-meter dash with a time of 10.86 seconds and the 200-meter dash in 21.70. A 2014 Academic All-State selection, he also won both the 100 (10.87) and the 200 (21.78) at the Class AA East Regional meet.

Daum has maintained a 3.87 GPA in the classroom. A member of the National Honor Society, he has volunteered locally on behalf of multiple area food and clothing drives to benefit families in need and as a youth football and track coach.

"Dalton Daum is truly a gifted track and field athlete," said Butte High head coach Arie Grey. "He has proven that he is a very smooth and explosive sprinter."

Daum will begin his senior year of high school this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by the Gatorade high school sports leadership team in partnership with USA TODAY High School Sports, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.
