NOTRE DAME ACADEMY STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® MASSACHUSETTS VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

She concluded her junior year with 1,518 assists in her prep volleyball career.

Cox has maintained a weighted 4.11 GPA in the classroom. The editor of the school newspaper, she has volunteered locally in association with the Notre Dame Academy Key Club and has donated her time helping senior citizens understand technology through Teens Teaching Technology.

"Corinne Cox has excellent ball-handling skills and can place a set anywhere on the court to anywhere else on the court," said Kali Joseph, head coach of Ursuline Academy. "Her technique is so strong that it is difficult to read where she is going to place her sets."

Cox will begin her senior year of high school next fall.
