FOOTHILL HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE NEVADA BOYS SOCCER PLAYER OF THE YEAR

CHICAGO (February 12, 2015) — In its 30th year of honoring the nation's best high school athletes, The Gatorade Company, in collaboration with USA TODAY High School Sports, today announced Jackson Dietrich of Foothill High School as its 2014-15 Gatorade Nevada Boys Soccer Player of the Year. Dietrich is the first Gatorade Nevada Boys Soccer Player of the Year to be chosen from Foothill High School.

The 5-foot-11, 165-pound senior midfielder and forward scored 28 goals and passed for 24 assists this past season, leading the Falcons (19-5) to the Division I state tournament play-in game. A two-time All-Sunrise Conference selection, he concluded his prep soccer career with 35 goals and 42 assists.

Dietrich has maintained a 3.15 weighted GPA in the classroom and represents one of the state's top academic candidates in meeting the Gatorade award's broad criteria. He has volunteered locally at an assisted living center and as a youth soccer coach.

"Jackson is very skilled with and off the ball," said Gerald Pentsil, head coach of Eldorado High. "He seemed to always make his team better."

Dietrich remains undecided upon a collegiate destination.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by the Gatorade high school sports leadership team in partnership with USA TODAY High School Sports, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.
