## DOWLING CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® IOWA GIRLS BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The 6-foot-1 senior forward averaged 18.9 points, 6.2 rebounds this past season, leading the Maroons to the Class 5A semifinals. A 2014 First Team All-State selection, Faber led all of Class 5A in field goal percentage (61.4) and ranked fifth in points per game. She also posted regular season averages of 2.6 assists and 1.9 assists per game while shooting 61.6 percent inside the arc and 86 percent from the free throw line.

Faber has maintained a 3.82 GPA in the classroom. She has volunteered locally on behalf of the Miracle League and at a food pantry in addition to delivering holiday gift baskets to families in need.

"Audrey Faber has grown into one of the best players I have coached in more than 40 years of coaching," said Dowling Catholic High head coach Bob Hanson. "She has developed into a complete and versatile player who is comfortable playing any position. She has also grown into an outstanding young woman who has led our team to much success. She will be a certain success in whatever she undertakes."

Faber has signed a National Letter of Intent to play basketball on scholarship at Creighton University this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by the Gatorade high school sports leadership team in partnership with USA TODAY High School Sports, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.
