LINN-MAR HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE IOWA GIRLS TRACK & FIELD ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

CHICAGO (June 17, 2015) — In its 30th year of honoring the nation's best high school athletes, The Gatorade Company, in collaboration with USA TODAY High School Sports, today announced Stephanie Jenks of Linn-Mar High School as its 2014-15 Gatorade Iowa Girls Track & Field Athlete of the Year. Jenks is the first Gatorade Iowa Girls Track & Field Athlete of the Year to be chosen from Linn-Mar High School.

The award, which recognizes not only outstanding athletic excellence, but also high standards of academic achievement and exemplary character demonstrated on and off the track, distinguishes Jenks as Iowa's best high school girls track & field athlete. Now a finalist for the prestigious Gatorade National Girls Track & Field Athlete of the Year award to be announced in June, Jenks joins an elite alumni association of state award-winners in 12 sports, including Allyson Felix (2001-02, Los Angeles Baptist, Calif.), Derek Jeter (1991-92, Kalamazoo HS, Mich.), Candace Parker (2001-02, Naperville Central HS, Ill.), Abby Wambach (1997-98, Our Lady of Mercy, N.Y.), Mark Sanchez (2004-05, Mission Viejo HS, Calif.), Lolo Jones (1997-98, Roosevelt HS, Ia.) and Bianca Knight (2006-07, Ridgeland HS, Miss.).

The 5-foot-5 junior distance runner won the 800-meter run with a time of 2:11.09, the 1500-meter run in 4:27.76 and set a state record in the 3000-meter run in 9:34.55, leading the Lions to a second-place finish as a team at the Class 4A state meet this spring. Also the state's 2012-13 Gatorade Girls Track & Field Athlete of the Year, Jenks was also a triple-event winner at the Drake Relays, winning the 800 in 2:09.64, the 1500 in 4:31.09 and the 3000 in 9:33.81, the last of which ranked as the nation's No. 2 performance among prep competitors in 2015.

Jenks has maintained a 4.0 GPA in the classroom. A member of the National Honor Society, she is a second-degree black belt in Tae Kwon Do and has volunteered locally on behalf of Habitat for Humanity.

"Stephanie Jenks's persistent training and determination to succeed at the highest level has resulted in her being amongst the best in the history of Iowa high school track & field," said Linn-Mar High head coach Nathan Hopp. "She continues to push the envelope and work towards higher accomplishments and achievements for herself every time she gets on the track."

Jenks will begin her senior year of high school this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by the Gatorade high school sports leadership team in partnership with USA TODAY High School Sports, which work with top sport-specific experts and a media advisory board of accomplished, veteran prep sports journalists to determine the state winners in each sport.

Two-time winner Jenks joins recent Gatorade Iowa Girls Track & Field Athletes of the Year Jalynn Roberts-Lewis (2013-14, Roosevelt High School), Rebekah Topham (2011-12, Griswold High School), Shelby Houlihan (2010-11, East High School), Hannah Willms (2009-10, Dike-New Hartford), Whitney Westrum (2008-09, Waukee), Betsy Flood (2007-08, Dowling Catholic), and Katie Flood (2006-07, Dowling Catholic) among the state's list of former award winners.
