## DUBLIN COFFMAN HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® OHIO VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Atherton has maintained a 3.93 GPA in the classroom. She has volunteered locally on behalf of Destination Imagination, the American Heart Association's Jump Rope for Heart event and as a youth volleyball coach.

"Hunter Atherton is the best high school setter that I've seen in my 20-year career," said John Buck, head coach at St. Ursula Academy. "She does it all. She runs the team and can make good hitters great and great hitters phenomenal."

Atherton has signed a National Letter of Intent to play volleyball on scholarship at the University of Nebraska in the fall of 2016.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport.
