## READING HIGH SCHOOL STANDOUT NAMED GATORADE® PENNSYLVANIA BOYS BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Walker averages 16.9 points, 6.2 rebounds, 4.2 assists and 1.7 blocks per game. The two-time Berks Player of the Year, he was a Second Team All-State selection as a sophomore. Walker is ranked as the nation's No. 23 recruit in the Class of 2017 by ESPN.

Walker has maintained a B average in the classroom. He has volunteered locally feeding the homeless and assisting youth basketball programs.

"Walker has very polished skills, a high basketball IQ and insane athletic ability," said Jon Treese, head coach at Muhlenberg High. "He has the ability to get into a zone and completely take a game over."

Walker will begin his senior year of high school this fall.

The Gatorade Player of the Year program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport.
