SOUTH ANCHORAGE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT-ATHLETE NAMED GATORADE ALASKA VOLLEYBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

CHICAGO (January 11, 2022) — In its 37th year of honoring the nation's best high school athletes, Gatorade today announced **Hanna Henrie** of **South Anchorage High School** is the **2021-22 Gatorade Alaska Volleyball Player of the Year**. Henrie is the sixth Gatorade Alaska Volleyball Player of the Year to be chosen from South Anchorage High School.

The award, which recognizes not only outstanding athletic excellence, but also high standards of academic achievement and exemplary character demonstrated on and off the court, distinguishes Henrie as Alaska's best high school volleyball player. Now a finalist for the prestigious Gatorade National Volleyball Player of the Year award to be announced in January, Henrie joins an elite alumni association of state award-winners, including USA Volleyball players Kayla Banwarth (2006-07, Wahlert High School, Iowa), Alisha Glass (2005-06, Leland Public High School, Mich.), Jordan Larson (2004-05, Logan View High School, Neb.) and Foluke Akinradewo (2004-05, St. Thomas High School, Fla.).

The 5-foot-11 senior outside hitter led the Wolverines to a 46-15 record and the Class 4A state championship this past season. Henrie compiled 697 kills with a .414 kill percentage, including eight kills in the final set of South's win over Dimond High in the state final. Henrie also tallied 429 digs, 73 service aces and 59 blocks. A 2021 American Volleyball Coaches Association Honorable Mention All-American

Henrie has donated her time making fleece blankets for patients at the Children's Hospital at the Providence Alaska Medical Center. She has also volunteered locally at the Food Bank of Alaska and as a youth volleyball coach. "Hanna displays fire, determination, hustle and humility," said Tufu Misi, head coach of Bartlett High School. "No matter where Hanna was on the court, she would always score."

Henrie has maintained a weighted 4.17 GPA in the classroom. She remains undecided upon a collegiate destination.

The <u>Gatorade Player of the Year</u> program annually recognizes one winner in the District of Columbia and each of the 50 states that sanction high school football, girls volleyball, boys and girls cross country, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, baseball, softball, and boys and girls track & field, and awards one National Player of the Year in each sport. The selection process is administered by the Gatorade Player of the Year Selection Committee, which leverages experts including coaches, scouts, media and others as sources to help evaluate and determine the state winners in each sport.

Henrie joins recent Gatorade Alaska Volleyball Players of the Year Kadyn Osborne (2020-21, Dimond High School), Hahni Johnson (2019-20 & 2018-19, Dimond High School), and Zoey Keene (2017-18, South Anchorage High School), among the state's list of former award winners.

Gatorade has a long-standing history of serving athlete communities and understands how sports instill valuable lifelong skills on and off the field. Through Gatorade's "Play it Forward" platform, Henrie has the opportunity to award a \$1,000 grant to a local or national organization of their choosing that helps young athletes realize the benefits of playing sports. Henrie is also eligible to submit a short video explaining why the organization they chose is deserving of one of twelve \$10,000 spotlight grants, which will be announced throughout the year. To date, Gatorade Player of the Year winners' grants have totaled more than \$3.5 million across more than 1,300 organizations.

Since the program's inception in 1985, Gatorade Player of the Year award recipients have won hundreds of professional and college championships, and many have also turned into pillars in their communities, becoming coaches, business owners and educators.
